


French Broad River Basin - Urbanization Increases Stormwater Flows

1) Illicit Discharges Are:

Discharges into storm drainage systems (pipes, streams, ditches, water bodies) which are not composed entirely of stormwater and have not been permitted.

***Can include land close to water.



2) Illicit Connections Are:


- Pipes discharging anything other than stormwater into the stormwater drainage system or directly into water bodies
- Examples:
 - PVC pipe draining from a washing machine
 - Wastewater pipe connected into a catch basin




Where does all that water go?

ID's Can Contain Pollutants:

- Heavy Metals
- Toxics
- Oil and Grease
- Solvents
- Nutrients
- Viruses and Bacteria



Most common types of discharges into storm sewer system include:

- Sediment
- Car wash runoff (commercial)
- Lawn debris
- Lawn fertilizers and pesticides
- Washdown from restaurants & construction debris
- Grease traps
- Automotive fluids

Look for:

- Any disposal, dumping, spill, leak, or other discharge of anything other than stormwater into or onto:
 - Stormwater catch basin
 - Stormwater drainage system
 - Any water body
 - Land in close proximity to any of the above so that the substance may reach the stormwater drainage system or any water body

Best Conditions for Finding ID's:

- Prolonged dry periods
- Non-growing season: fall winter early spring
- Low ground water levels
- Stop during rainfall



Key: No runoff event for the last 48 - 72 hours



Eyes / Nose / Ears:

Use your eyes

- Materials dumped illegally into storm drains?
- Small pipes draining and it hasn't rained?
- Spilled oil or paint, colored water, foam, floatables?

Use your nose

- Unusual odors
- Sewer smell
- Detergent 'clean' smell
- Fuel / oil

Use your ears

- Small pipes draining and it hasn't rained?



Note 'Stream-side' Activities -

- Construction Activity?
- Wastewater from sewers and septic systems?
- Vehicle maintenance activities?
- Industrial areas commercial sites?
- Direct dumping into storm drains or streams?



So - - How do You Tell Illicit Discharges from NonIllicit Discharges ???

- Can be <u>Difficult to Know</u><u>for Sure</u>
- Use Sight and Smell
- Key Dry Weather flows
- Follow-Up withTown StormwaterStaff



Not Illicit Discharges:

SURFACE WATER

- Residential, Charity Car Washing
- Springs
- Flows from riparian habitats and wetlands
- Landscape Irrigation
- Diverted Stream Flows
- Roof runoff piped to streams

GROUND WATER

- Uncontaminated, rising ground water
- Uncontaminated pumped ground water
- Foundation and footing drains
- Water from sump pumps (crawl space, basement pumps)

'Clean' Water Sources

- Waterline flushing
- Air Conditioner Condensate
- Dechlorinated backwash and draining swimming pools
- Street wash water
- Fire fighting runoff
- NPDES permitted discharges

Raleigh's Good Housekeeping – Illicit Discharge Program

- Complaint driven w/ education or fines as needed
- Annual inspections of facilities + additional inspections in problem areas
- 2016 200 complaints / 90 IDDE's
- Fines Increasing: 5 gal or less \$100 Larger spills \$1000 + / day
- Education focused on: restaurants, homeowners, and auto service shops






